Lesson fee is \$25.00.

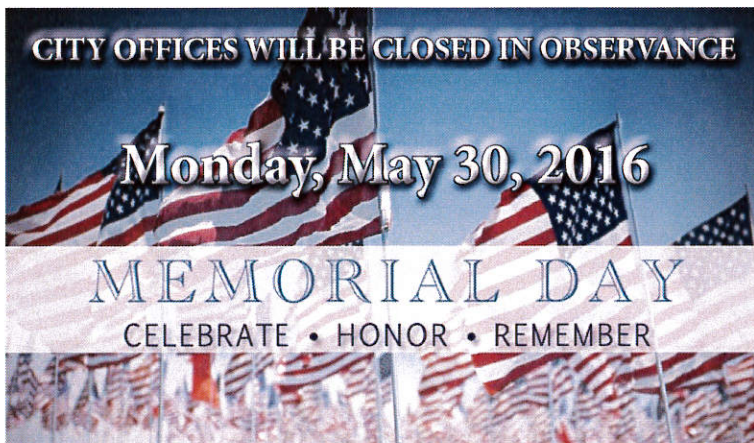
Times have yet to be set for swimming lessons. Be sure check with the pool after opening day to find out times and to pick up your registration form.

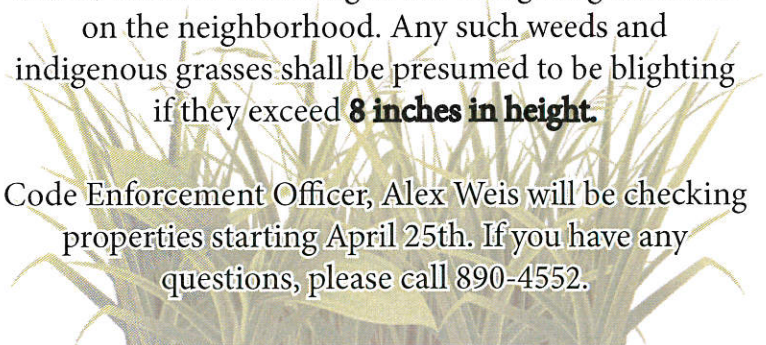

Code Spotlight

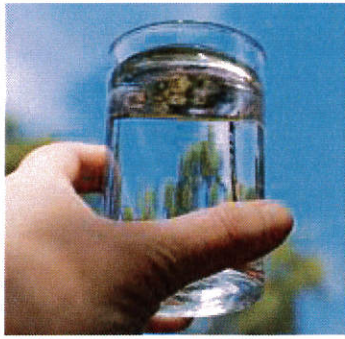
Section 7-502 Weeds and the Abatement thereof

Weeds and grasses on or about residential property which, because of its height, has a blighting influence on the neighborhood. Any such weeds and indigenous grasses shall be presumed to be blighting if they exceed **8 inches in height**.
