Fog Sealing Streets



Street fog sealing will be around the middle of September, barring unforeseen weather or mechanical difficulties. These are ONLY for the streets that were chip sealed last month.

Please move your vehicles away from the street, and do NOT water your yard that morning so that crews can fog seal the streets effectively. Any vehicles NOT moved from the street will be towed. Streets being fog sealed will be blocked to all through traffic for approximately two hours, depending on weather conditions.

Utility Line Tree Trimming



Notice from the Electric Department - Starting the end of September, the Electric Department will begin the annual trimming of the tree branches away from the primary and secondary electric power lines. OSHA rules and regulations addresses safety considerations related to line clearances as the trimming of any tree or brush that is within 10 feet of an electric power line. It is more effective to trim trees during the day than at night during a storm.

The City of Goodland is in the process of changing out older electric and water meters. We have several crews of men working throughout town.
