(Line-up starts at 5:00)

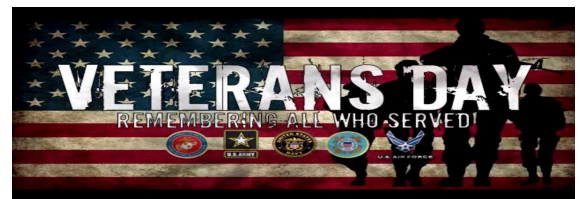
The parade will start at 17th and Main St. and travel down Main St. to the Goodland Activities Center (GAC).
