


Most of us have never thought about where the water comes from, when we turn on the faucet. The residents of Goodland get their water from 1 of 9 wells, operated by the Ctiv of Goodland. An example is shown

Understanding Water Wells and How They Work

A well is the most common way to obtain groundwater for household use. A well is basically a hole in the ground, held open by a pipe (or casing) that extends to an aquifer. A pump draws water from the aquifer for a distribution through the plumbing system. The depth to which wells constructed is determined by factors such as (1) depth to ground water, (2) the groundwater quality, and (3) the geologic conditions at the well site.
