

> <u>Look</u> for places fire could start. <u>Listen</u> for the sound of the smoke alarm. <u>Learn</u> two ways out of every room.


\*\*This is a great time to make sure smoke detectors are in working order and that batteries are changed every 6 months.

## Topside Trail Project Kicks Off, Seeks Donors

The Topside Trail Project is a massive enhancement to health, recreation and quality of life opportunities in our area. It is a comprehensive project aimed at the revitalization of Goodland and consists of 1.6 miles of **new** trail within Steever Park and the Northwest Tech campus. It will provide connectivity to downtown and eventually out into the county. A Dog Park and Welcome Center at the Van Gogh, Splash Pad and Amphitheater at Gulick Park and a natural grassland trail on the Northwest Tech campus are added points of interest. The impact on Sherman County will be substantial.

This project is **NOT** funded with taxpayer dollars. All money will come from grants, donations and some community laborers providing their time and expertise.
