Current members--as a thank you for your support, you are eligible to renew at the discounted rate, plus we have implemented a referral program where you can earn up to a free year of membership!

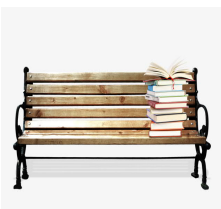
