Dead Trees Are Hazardous



With several heavy windstorms already hitting our community this summer, we want to remind residents of their responsibility to maintain trees on their property. If trees are not healthy and properly maintained, they can become a danger to neighboring property owners. Proper tree maintenance is the responsibility of the property owner, as the City will only trim tree branches which are encroaching on City power lines.

Keeping trees which are dead and/or diseased on your property is a violation of City code and should be removed expediently. There are several private Arborists in Goodland who are licensed with the City and can assist you with tree trimming and removal services. If you are concerned that a tree in your neighborhood could be dead, diseased, or otherwise hazardous, please contact the Code Enforcement Department at 785-890-4500.
