Since the purchase of the building in 2018, two offices are now being utilized and the lobby is ready to welcome visitors to our community. Retail items, such as post cards, magnets, key chains, shot glasses, t-shirts, bags, and coffee cups are displayed for purchase. Just recently, the parking lot was reformed by replacing old blacktop and concrete, with gravel for continuity with the Van Gogh viewing area. New window wraps of famous Van Gogh paintings were added as well. The improvements to the parking lot and windows were made possible with a grant by the Dane G. Hansen Foundation.
