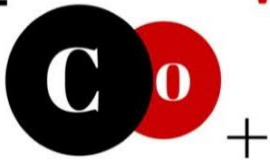

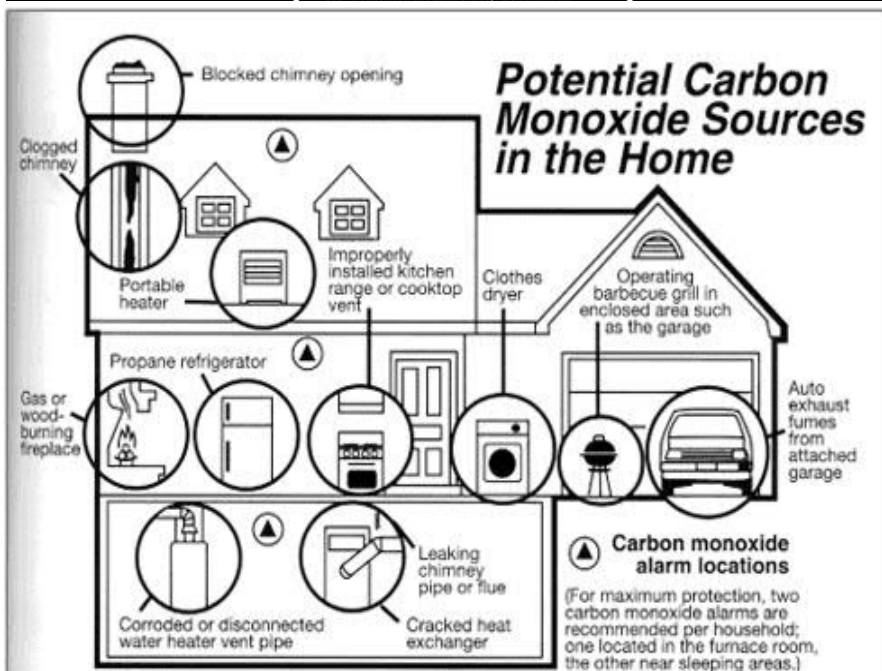
Call 911.

Prevention

- Install a CO alarm near every sleeping area of the home and it's not covered by furniture or draperies.
- In the winter never use gas appliances such as ranges, ovens, or clothes dryers to heat your home.
- Don't cover the bottom of natural gas or propane ovens with aluminum foil. Doing so blocks the combustion air flow through the appliance and can produce CO.



Service Line Warranty Program

The City of Goodland is notifying residents of a service line warranty program being provided by Service Line Warranties of America (SWLA), a National League of Cities (NLC) and Kansas League of Municipalities partner.

The NLC Service Line Warranty program offers citizens an affordable way to avoid the unexpected and often large expense involved with a water line break. When a line breaks, the cost to repair it can often cause hardship on a family's budget. This new program will offer warranty protection to help cover the cost of a break. We have chosen to participate in this program for several reasons including that it is offered at no cost to the City and it serves to educate our homeowners on their service line responsibilities while saving them money on repairs.

Other Benefits:

- It's the only Service Line Program endorsed by the National League of Cities and by the League of Kansas Municipalities.
- Free Public Awareness Campaign
- Peace of Mind—with one toll-free call a reputable plumber is dispatched.
- All repairs performed to code by local licensed contractors.
- Contractors undergo rigorous vetting process to ensure quality service.



Residents—You will soon see a mailing from Utility Service Partners **with a City logo**. This mailing will give you information on the Service Line Warranty.

While the City of Goodland entered into a marketing agreement with SLWA to highlight the availability of the program to our residents, the program is OPTIONAL. You should only participate if you believe the program is right for you.
