

These benches were purchased through Champlin Tire Recycling, Inc. in Concordia, KS. Pollution and energy consumption both are reduced when tires are recycled which is one of the many benefits of recycling tires. Many valuable materials can be made from recycled tires including tables and benches. We appreciate that these durable benches add restful seating to our Topside Trail Project - Goodland!
