Saving Water in the Summer

1 Water early in the morning

Wind speeds tend to be slower and temperatures are lower in the early morning. Watering in the morning can reduce water loss from evaporation.

2 Add mulch to planting beds

Mulch also helps with reducing water evaporation. A 2-inch cover of mulch will retain moisture around roots and in the soil, as well as help suppress weeds.

3 Check for leaks and fix them

Leaks and slow drips at connections and faucets are often easy fixes. Make sure to check the ends of hoses for drips as well.

4 Only water when needed

More plants die from over-watering than not watering enough. Check soil moisture by digging a hole next to roots to check for moisture. When walking across your lawn, if the grass springs back quickly, it does not need water.

5 Recycle Rainwater

Capturing and reusing rainwater is a great way to conserve water. A 1,000 sq. ft. rooftop can collect up to 420 gallons for every inch of rain.

Here is some information and guidance from **Sherman County 911 Dispatch/Communications**:

- *Sirens are tested by dispatch on the first Wednesday of every month at 11:45am. If there is inclement weather, it is postponed to the 2nd Wednesday of the month.
- *Sirens are sounded by dispatch if there is a tornado warning issued close to or within the city limits. If we receive a report from a citizen, we quickly report it to the NWS. With their guidance, we determine if the siren should be sounded.
- *Sirens are meant to warn only those who are **OUTDOORS**. Those who are indoors should stay informed to weather changes by using local media sources.
- *What is your plan for warnings issued while you and your family are sleeping? Weather radios are sold at numerous retailers. They are inexpensive and can be customized to sound an alarm for certain types of warnings.
- *Wireless device apps can also serve as an alternate method of receiving alerts. Most news stations offer free apps with customizable alerts.
- *Public storm shelters are now available near the Sparks and Handy Towers on Cherry St.
- *As a courtesy, please do not call dispatch to ask why the sirens are going off. We do not take sounding the sirens lightly. If they sound, there's a valid reason. Refer to media outlets for updates regarding the storm. Thank you for understanding.
- *During power outages, please know that the City will be aware of outages and will be working on them. Please do not call dispatch to report outages. You may try to reach the Power Plant, but most likely employees will be working to restore power.

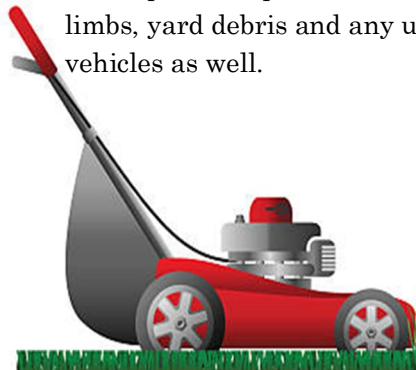

GENERAL NOTICE

The Building Inspector will be doing yard inspections and as the weather warms up & grasses/weeds start to grow, make sure your yards/property stay compliant to the City Code and that all grasses/weeds stay cut **below 8 inches**. This includes sidewalks, streets, alleys, easements, right-of-ways and any other areas, public or private. Be sure to remove any brush, tree limbs, yard debris and any unlicensed or abandoned vehicles as well.
