The Electric Department has begun the annual trimming of the tree branches away from the primary and secondary electric power lines. OSHA rules and regulations addresses safety considerations related to line clearances as the trimming of any tree or brush that is within 10 feet of an electric power line.

It is more effective to trim trees during the day than at night during a storm!
