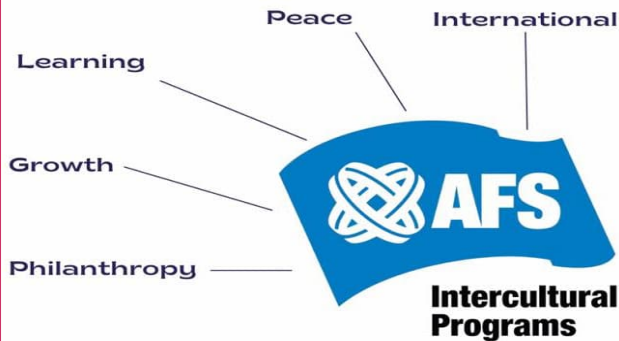

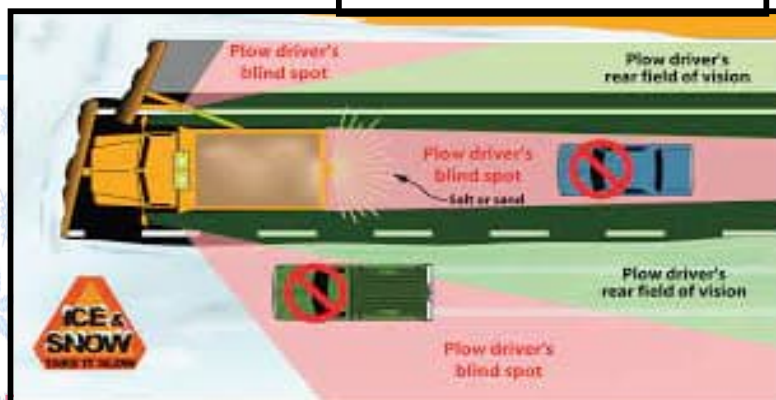

Don't Crowd the Plow!



SHOVEL SMART!



Shoveling heavy, wet snow can cause back injuries and heart attacks. Don't push yourself!

Snow Removal Ordinances

It shall be unlawful for any person who is the owner or occupant of any lot abutting upon any sidewalk in the commercial district of the City of Goodland, either zoned as C-1 or C-2, to fail to remove from such sidewalks all snow and ice by noon following a snow storm.

No person shall place snow, removed from private property, upon any public street, alley or sidewalk.
