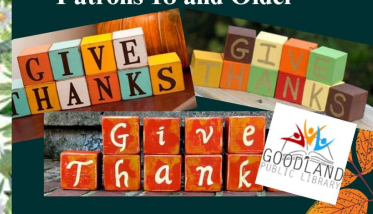

Code Enforcement Corner

Sec. 15-503. - Placing of *snow*; penalty.

(a) No person shall place snow, removed from private property, upon any public street, alley or sidewalk.

(b) Any person violating the provisions of this section shall upon conviction be fined not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$100.00.

Sec. 15-501. - Duty to remove snow and ice from sidewalks

It shall be unlawful for any person who is the owner or occupant of any lot abutting upon any sidewalk in the

commercial district of the City of Goodland, either zoned as C-1 or C-2, to fail to remove from such sidewalks all snow and ice by noon following a snow storm.
