Code Enforcement Corner

Sec 15-305: It shall be unlawful for any person owning or controlling any hedge, hedge fence and shrubbery bordering on any street, alley or sidewalk in this city to permit the same to grow to a height of more than four feet, or so as to overhang and obstruct any sidewalk, alley or street.

Sec 15-309: There shall be a minimum clearance of 14 feet between the street surface and overhanging branches of any tree abutting any street and a minimum clearance of ten feet between any sidewalk and the overhanging branches of any tree abutting said sidewalk.
